Ota vastuuta myös muiden osallistujien kokemuksesta. Kuuntele ja kannusta.



## Library guide

#### **3UAS libraries**

 Haaga-Helia, Laurea and Metropolia libraries (3AMK libraries) have a joint library system. 3UAS customer can use the same library card in all 3UAS libraries.

#### **Library services**

 are available immediately by applying for a library card and then adding it to personal HH Finna –account. The card allows you to, among other things, borrow course books free of charge. Course books are available both in electronic and print format. It's also worthwhile to use library's study facilities, as well as take part in library's information search training.


#### **Library card**

• The easiest way to get a library card is to download the Tuudo app, where you can make yourself a mobile library card (you have to have a Finnish personal identity code in Haaga-Helia student registry for this to work). If you want a traditional plastic card, please fill in our library card application online and pick up the card in the library (remember to take your ID with you).





- Make sure that freshers are having fun. It's their party.








## Membership of 3,5 years + coveralls

## How to use kide.app

- Go to App Store or Google Play or use the website kide.app
- You can login with Facebook or by creating an account
- All event tickets ect are on sale in Kide.App

Kide.app has their own student card too!



### Slice

- Slice is a free app that also works as a personal student card for secondary school and university students
- Companies that offer student benefits can be identified by the blue Slice heart sticker on the street

- With a Slice student card, you get significant student benefits throughout the country
- By showing the app's student card, you can get a refund for school meals at Haaga-Helia campuses





### **How to use Slice?**

- Buy membership on kide.app and wait
   2-3 working days
- 2. Go to slice.fi/upload
- 3. Select Haaga-Helia
- 4. Fill the form to receive the activation code (your information needs to match the information you've given in the form to join Helga, which you can check from Helga's web store in the "Memberships" -section of your profile)
- Download the Slice app from Google Play or App Store



- 6. Check your phone's settings to give the app permission to give notifications on important bulletins
- 7. Give the app the permission to use your phone's gallery
- 8. Open the app and log in
- 9. Enter the username and password you received via email (activation code)
- Accept the terms, the app can't be used before that



## **Pivo**

- **1.** Download Pivo on your phone and deploy it by login in with your online bank service credentials (requires a Finnish bank account)
- **2.** Open Pivo and choose 'Student-ID'
- **3.** Start using it by following the instructions on the app

The Kela meal benefit can be used even without the Helga membership.

## FSHS / YTHS

## **FSHS (YTHS in Finnish)**

- As a customer of the FSHS, you will have access 24 service units around Finland. There is three in Helsinki metropolitan area: Töölö,
   Malmi and Otaniemi.
  - In Porvoo and Vierumäki local students can use partner service providers (Mehiläinen and Terveystalo) and also the FSHS service points around Finland.
- own service units. The service units operated by partners are only for the students studying in these towns.

Services are produced by FSHS Espoo and FSHS Helsinki, Töölö.


Services are produced by FSHS Helsinki, Malmi and FSHS Helsinki, Töölö.



### **FSHS** healthcare fee

- The healthcare fee must be paid by all students who are encompassed by FSHS services.
   The healthcare fee must be paid to KELA irrespective of whether the student uses FSHS services or not.
- The health care fee will be **73,60** euros in **2023**. According to the act, the fee can be paid in two rates which amounts to **36,80** euros per semester.
- The healthcare fee must be paid to KELA every term, i.e. twice a year or once at a time.
  Please note that KELA will not send you an invoice, so you must pay the fee on your own initiative. The due dates will depend on the date of your registration as an attending student.
- 30.9. is the due date for FSHS payment in autumn semester 2023.
